Title: **COBIT2019 Overview and Foundation, including Exam**

Course Description.

COBIT is a framework for the governance and management of enterprise Information and Technology that supports enterprise goal achievement.

This Foundation course is intended for new users to COBIT who are interested in achieving the foundation certificate.

This two day foundation course highlights the concepts, models and key definitions of the COBIT framework.

Duration. 3 days

Prerequisites. None

- Recognize the target audience of COBIT 2019.
- Recognize the context, benefits and key reasons COBIT is used as an information and technology governance framework.
- Recognize the descriptions and purposes of the COBIT product architecture.
- Recall the alignment of COBIT with other applicable frameworks, standards and bodies of knowledge.
- Understand and describe the governance “system” and governance “framework” principles.
- Describe the components of a governance system.
- Understand the overall structure and contents of the Goals Cascade.
- Recall the 40 Governance and Management Objectives and their purpose statements.
- Understand the relationship between Governance and Management Objectives and Governance Components.
- Differentiate COBIT based performance management using maturity and capability perspectives.
- Discover how to design a tailored governance system using COBIT.
- Explain the key points of the COBIT business case.
- Understand and recall the phases of the COBIT implementation approach.
- Describe the relationships between the COBIT Design and Implementation Guides.
- Prepare for the COBIT 2019 Foundation exam.

Exams

Foundation Exam

The COBIT Foundation exam is designed to test the candidate's knowledge of the framework as opposed to memorization.

Specific exam information includes:

- Online proctored exam
- 75 multiple choice questions
- Closed-book
- One correct answer for each question, using three choices (A, B or C)
- Two hour duration
- Pass rate is 65% or 49 correct answers out of 75

COBIT 2019 Foundation Training Format

The COBIT 2019 Foundation training class format is as follows

- 2 consecutive days training
- 3rd day for the exam and preparation
 - Half-day exam preparatory morning session
 - A two-hour certification exam, consisting of 75 questions for those who have no former COBIT5 certification.

Trainer

Your trainer will be Ms. Greet VOLDERS who has many years experience as an ISACA Certified COBIT Trainer.

Greet Volders obtained a degree in Mathematics (1984) and a Masters in Computer Audit (1995). She is Certified for Governance of Enterprise IT (CGEIT), COBIT Certified Assessor, and Certified Information Privacy Manager (CIPM).

In 1995, she started her own consultancy company Voquals N.V. Within Voquals, she is responsible for setting the strategy, for creating the business and for supervising all consultancy assignments and coaching the consultants working for Voquals.

Her main activity is providing advice for our customers, and regularly she gives trainings & seminars related to Enterprise Governance of I&T, Process Improvement and IT/Business alignment. In 2004, Greet became an accredited trainer for the COBIT foundation training and the IT Governance Implementation training, using COBIT, which she continued for COBIT5.

She is a regular speaker at ISACA events, such as seminars and trainings for ISACA Belgium, presentations at EuroCACS in 2011, 2012 and 2013, and the COBIT Conference in 2015.

Since 2002, Greet is an active member in several development teams for COBIT and she is regularly asked as an Expert Reviewer for different ISACA publications.

Next to that she is also specialised in the optimisation of internal processes conform to various ISO standards, Information Security, SOX and CMMI.

In this context, she executed a lot of assessments and audits to check the conformance to these control frameworks in several companies. Preparing companies for a compliance-audit conforming ISO-standards is another field of expertise.
